The Thousand Names of Shri Dattatreya

Shri Sūta is narrating the Brahmanda Purana to the Sages who ask:

**Nikhil'āgama tattva-gñya Brahma-gñyāna-parāyaṇa
Vad'āsmākam mukty'upāyam Sūta sarv'opa-kārakam**
